POINTS TO PONDER

Who shall be able to stand

Will the righteous suffer same as wicked

Rev 7:1 four angels, four corners of earth, holding 4 winds

- a. Isa 57:13; Jer 18:17; Psa 104:4; Heb 1:7
- b. Gen 18:23 destroy righteous...

Rev 7:2 angel from the east

- a. seal of living God
- b. cried to four angels
- c. to whom given to hurt earth, sea

Rev 7:3 hurt not earth, sea, trees

- a. till sealed servants of our God in foreheads

Rev 7:4 number sealed

- a. 144K
- b. of all the tribes of Israel

Rev 7:5-8 Juda, Reuben, Gad, Aser, Nephtalim, Manasses, Simeon, Levi, Issachar, Zabulon, Joseph, Benjamin

Rev 7:9 after this ... beheld, lo

- a. a great multitude
- b. no man could number
- c. all nations, kindreds, people, tongues
- d. stood before the throne, before the Lamb
- e. clothed with whit robes, palms in their hands

Rev 7:10 cried, loud voice,

- a. Salvation to our God
- b. and unto the Lamb

Rev 7:11 all the angels stood round throne

- a. about the elders, four beasts

- b. fell before the throne on their faces
- c. worshipped God

Rev 7:12 Amen: Blessing, glory, wisdom, thanksgiving, honour, power, might

- a. unto our God for ever and ever

Rev 7:13 what are these in white robes

- a. whence came they

Rev 7:14 Sir, thou knowest

- a. these came out of great tribulation
- b. washed their robes
- c. made them white in the blood of the Lamb

Rev 7:15 therefore are they before the throne

- a. serve him day and night in his temple
- b. and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them

Rev 7:16 they shall hunger no more

- a. neither thirst; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.

Rev 7:17 the Lamb in the midst of the throne shall feed them

- a. lead them unto living fountains of water
- b. God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes
