15. Rev 9:12 one woe is past'. behold
 - a. there come two woes more hereafter
16. Rev 9:13 sixth angel sounded
 - a. voice from four horns of golden altar ... before God
17. Rev 9:14 saying to sixth angel
 - a. which hath the trumpet
 - b. Loose four angels bound in Euphrates
18. Rev 9:15 four angels loosed
 - a. which prepared for an hour, a day, and a month, and a year
 - b. to slay the third part of men
19. Rev 9:16 the number of the army of horsemen
 - a. two hundred thousand, thousand
 - b. I heard the number of them
20. Rev 9:17 I saw the horses in the vision
 - a. them that sat on them
 - b. having breastplates of fire and of jacinth, and brimstone
