


**MARCH 30TH

SELF-HARM AWARENESS MONTH

Self-Injury is a deliberate, non-suicidal behavior that inflicts physical harm on one's body to relieve emotional distress. It's important to note that self-injury does not involve a conscious intent to die by suicide - The clinical term for this behavior is called Non-Suicidal Self Injury (NSSI) it can take many forms from cutting, picking, burning, bruising, puncturing, embedding, scratching or hitting one's self, just to name a few.
