Things to Look For Signs in heaven: Woman, red dragon Stars Child War in heaven Salvation Messiah

#### Rev 12:1 A great sign in heaven

- a. a woman clothed with the sun
- b. moon under her feet
- c. crown twelve stars on head
- 1. Who is the woman

Rev 12:2 pregnant, travailing in birth, pained to be delivered

Rev 12:3 great red dragon, 7 heads, ten horns, 7 crowns, tail drew 1/3 stars

- a. flung them to the earth
- b. dragon stood in front of woman who was about to give birth (Matt 2:2.7-8,16)
- c. so it could devour child the moment he was born
- d. who will rule all nations ... iron scepter (Isaiah 9:6-7)

Rev 12:5 child snatched up to God and to his throne (Matt 2:13)

Rev 12:6 woman fled into the wilderness

- a. a place prepared for her by God
