

In the original language of the New Testament there are three verbs that are used to convey three total different actions



1. EPICHEO (EPP EE HAY OH – "To POUR upon" - appears one time in the New Testament - Luke 10:34

"And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him."



2. RHANTIZO (RON TEED ZO) – "To SPRINKLE," - It's used in a ceremonial or ritual context, particularly in reference to purification rites. The word is found four times in Hebrews. 9:13, 9:19, 9:21, and 10:22



Hebrews. 9:13 - "For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:" (reference to Number 19:1-22 specifically verse 13)



3. BAPTISMA – "To immerse, submersion, to dip."



Acts 8:36 - 38

36. "And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized?"

37. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

38And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him.






JESUS STATES WE MUST BE BORN OF THE WATER

John 3:5

"Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God."



MARK 16:15-16

Baptism essential to our SALVATION. It is a command from Jesus Christ.





Acts 2:38 KJV- by the authority. We are baptized by the Authority of Christ into the possession of Christ.



Matthew 28:19 ASV— into the name of—was a common phrase for the transference of ownership.



Matthew 28:19 ASV — into the possession of indicates that one belongs to the one whose name he is baptized. We belong to that possession.



hew 28:18 NASB d Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority (power) aven and on earth has been given to Me.



Acts 2:38 — Baptism is commanded by the authority of Jesus Christ our Lord.

Matthew 28:18

All authority in heaven ... This teaches the divinity of Christ. If these words were spoken by a mere man, they are nonsense; and therefore in this statement Christ lays claim to status as a member of the Godhead.

Ten times in the Greek New Testament, Christ is actually called God (see <u>John 1:1</u>; <u>John 20:28</u>; <u>Acts 20:28</u>; <u>Romans 9:5</u>; <u>Philippians 2:6</u>; <u>Hebrews 1:8</u>; <u>Titus 2:13</u>; <u>2 Peter 1:1</u>; <u>1 John 5:20</u>; <u>Revelation 1:8</u>; also <u>Colossians 2:9</u> and <u>John 14:9</u>).


This says nothing of the countless passages in which he laid claim to attributes of deity, as for example when he said, "Before Abraham was, I am!" Christ is God come in the flesh. That is the central meaning and message of Christianity. Anything less than this regarding Christ is blasphemous.



WE ARE TO BE BATIZED BY THE AUTHORITY OF CHRIST INTO THE POSSESSION OF CHRIST.









PETER TEACHES WE RECEIVE A GIFT AT BAPTISM

Acts 2:38

"Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost."

Acts 22:16 – to wash away our sins

Acts 22:16

"And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord."

Romans 6:2-5 – Baptized Puts us into Christ

2. "God forbid, how shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therin? 3. "Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?"

Romans 6:4-5 – Baptized puts us into Christ

4. "Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life."

5. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

Colossians 2:12 – We are buried with Christ, and rise to live a new Life

Colossains 2:12

12. "Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead."

Galatians 3:27 – We Put on Christ

Galatians 3:27

"For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ."

Acts 2:47 - Baptism puts us in the Church

Acts 2:47

"Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved."

1 Corinthians 12:13 — Baptism puts us in the One body the Church

I Corinthians 12:13

"For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit."

Galatians 3:27 KJV - Put on Christ

Galatians 3:27

"For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ."

Acts 8:35-39 KJV - REJOICING

³⁵ Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus.



BAPTISM - baptisma




immersion, submersion

1.of calamities and afflictions with which one is quite overwhelmed

2. of John's baptism, that purification rite by which men on confessing their sins were bound to spiritual reformation, obtained the pardon their past sins and became qualified for the benefits of the Messiah's kingdom soon to be set up. This was valid Christian baptism, as this was the only baptism the apostles received and it is not recorded anywhere that they were ever rebaptised after Pentecost.

3. of Christian baptism; a rite of immersion in water as commanded by Christ, by which one after confessing his sins and professing his faith in Christ, having been born again by the Holy Spirit unto a new life, identifies publicly with the fellowship of Christ and the church.
