




What does UNDENOMINATION mean?

"Undenominational" means not affiliated with a specific religious denomination or group. It describes something that is not restricted to or associated with a particular religious organization. This term is often used in the context of schools, churches, or other institutions that aim to be inclusive and not promote a specific denominational viewpoint.

2. "And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it." (SINGULAR)

IF CHRIST BUILT ONE CHURCH

There are an estimated 45,000 Christian denominations worldwide. This number reflects the vast diversity within Christianity, with various groups interpreting scripture and practicing their faith in different ways. Some publications even state this number as of 2024.

THE ONENESS OF CHRIST EPHESIANS 3:9-11 – THE CHURCH ORGIN

- 9"And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:
- 10To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,
- 11According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:

- 13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

- 20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;

THE ONENESS OF CHRIST ACTS 2:41-47 – THE LORD ADDED TO THE ONE CHURCH

- ⁴⁵ And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need.
- 46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,
 - · "Praising God, and having favour with all the people.
 - And the Lord
 - · added to the church daily such as should be saved."

- 23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.




THE ONENESS OF CHRIST JOHN 17:20-21 – JESUS PRAYS THAT WE ALL BE ONE




I CORINTHIANS 1:10 UNITY

- ▶ I Corinthians 1:10 is a call for unity within the Christian church, specifically the church in Corinth. Paul urges believers to be in agreement, to avoid divisions, and to be united in their thinking and judgment. This emphasis on unity is rooted in the believers' shared identity in Christ and their common allegiance to Him as Lord.
- In the Name of Jesus Christ:
- ▶ Paul's appeal is made "in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ," highlighting the authority and significance of Christ's name and the importance of unity within his body.
- Agreement and Unity:
- ▶ Paul urges the Corinthians to "agree" and to be "perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment." This highlights the need for doctrinal and relational harmony within the church.
- No Divisions:
- ► The call for unity is further emphasized by Paul's plea that there be "no divisions" among them. This directly addresses the issue of factions and disagreements that were present in the Corinthian church.



- 13. For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.


THE SEED IS THE WORD OF GOD - LUKE 8:4-15

- ⁴ And when much people were gathered together, and were come to him out of every city, he spake by a parable:
- ⁵ A sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it.
- ⁶ And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it lacked moisture.
- ⁷ And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprang up with it, and choked it.
- ⁸ And other fell on good ground, and sprang up, and bare fruit an hundredfold. And when he had said these things, he cried, He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

- ¹² Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.





THE SEED IS THE WORD OF GOD - LUKE 8:4-15

⁸ But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.


⁹As we said before, so say I now again, if any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

Modern Churches Timeline

From the New Testament to Today



With tens of thousands of different churches and denominations, with their opposing beliefs and practices in the world today, we are often left confused. Which church is the "right" church? Which church does God approve? Which church did Christ establish? In Acts 2, we read of the one true church that was established by Jesus Christ and sanctioned by God. Many religious groups have departed from the first century church, splintering into the various churches and denominations we see today. If we seek to be the one true church established by Jesus Christ in the first century, as described in Acts 2, we must rid ourselves of man-made creeds, doctrines and traditions, and become the first century church we read about in the New Testament.
