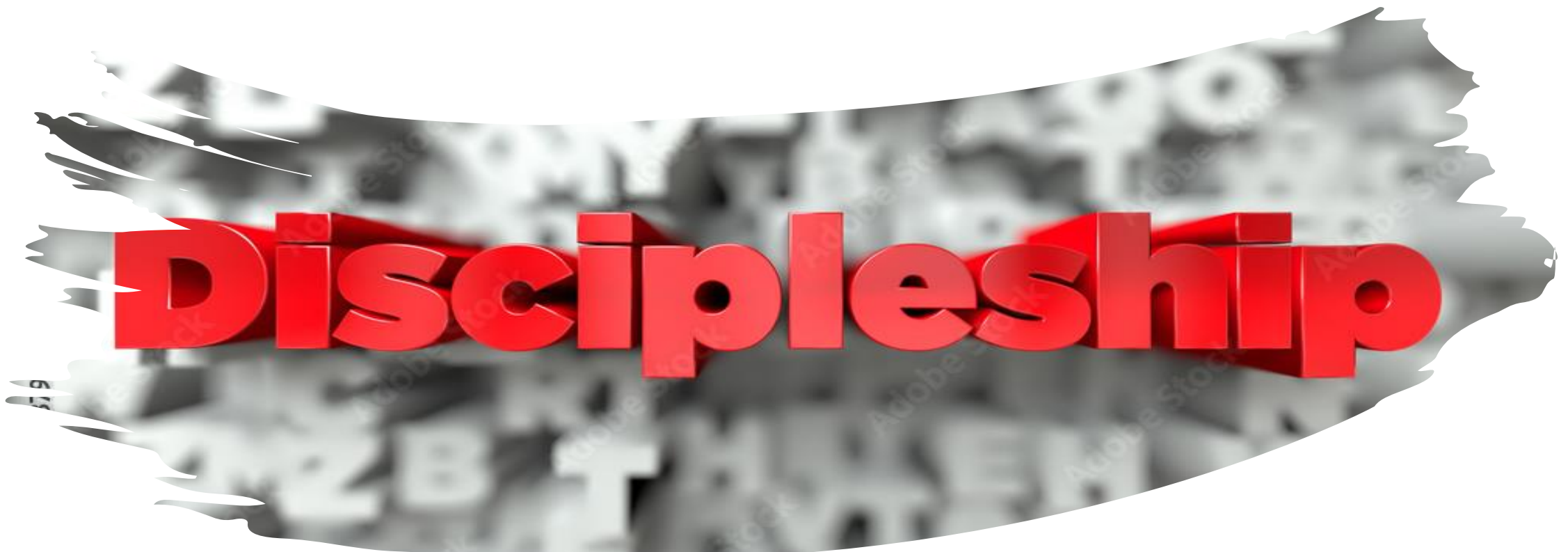

CHRIST'S TEACHING METHODS



Discipleship

Some of Christ's Methods - He connected spiritual lessons to everyday life

Parables: Luke 10:29-37 (Good Samaritan); Luke 15:11-32 (Prodigal Son); Matthew 13:3-8 (Seed);

Everyday objects: Used seeds, sheep, and coins to explain spiritual ideas. Show God's love and human duty.

Asking Questions and Dialogue – Luke 20:20-26 (Paying Taxes to Ceasar); Luke 12:57 (What is right); Luke 10:26 (What is written in the law); Matthew 22:41-46 (Jesus asks who son the Messiah is)

Asked questions to make listeners think instead of just giving answers. Prompted people to answer their own moral questions.

Action and Demonstration – John 13:1-17 (Jesus washes disciples' feet); Matthew 14:15-21 (Feeding the 5,000); Mark 4:39 (Storm be still)

*Used physical acts to teach humility. He performed **Miracles** to show God's power and authority.*

Christ's Methods - He connected spiritual lessons to everyday life

Rhetoric and Memorable Sayings: Matthew 5:29 (Gouge in right eye); Matthew 7:12 GOLDEN RULE (Whatever you man to do unto you, do to them)

*Used extreme exaggeration to shock listeners into awareness.
Used short, catchy proverbs like the Golden Rule.*

- ***Religious Opposition & Critics - Pharisees & Sadducees; Scribes & Lawyers***

1 PETER 4:1-4

1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin;

2 That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.

²³ and while being abusively insulted, He did not insult in return; while suffering, He did not threaten, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously;

²⁴ and He Himself brought our sins in His body up on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live for righteousness; by His wounds you were healed.

²⁵ For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian ✦
