It shows our lack of power, knowledge, and control. It is lacking faith or struggling against temptation.

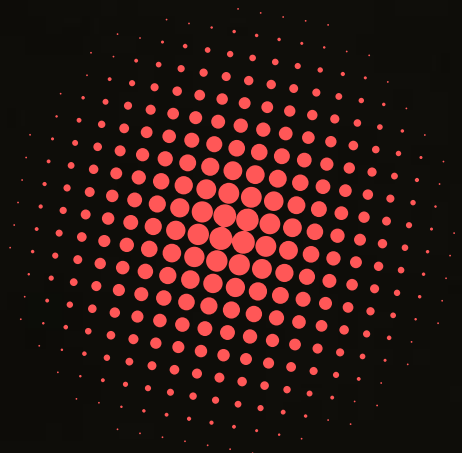


Scripture – I Peter 5:8

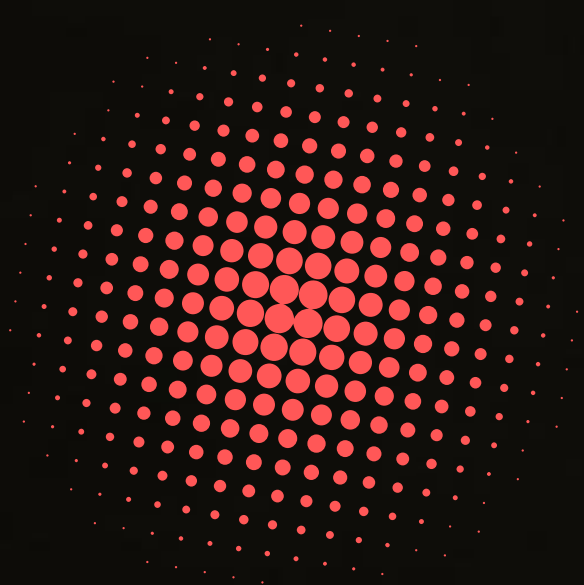


Lies and Deception - The devil has been called “the great deceiver.”

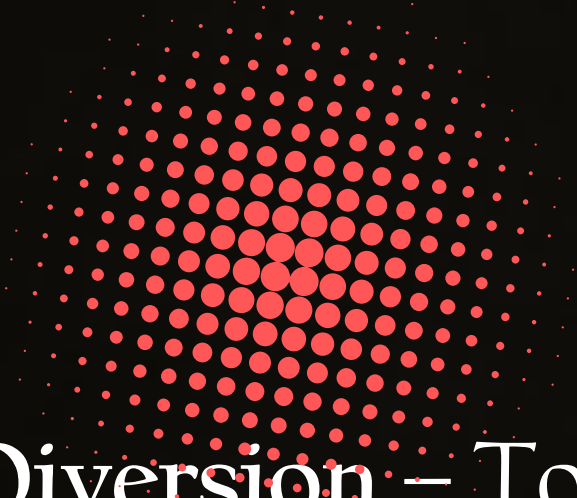


Contention or Division –Satan is the father of confusion, conflict and division.

Romans 16:17 - NIV ¹⁷ I urge you, *brothers and sisters, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them.*



Recognize and Understand Satan's Tactics



Diversion – To be diverted means is to be turned away from what is our primary goal or task. The most critical focus is God and the good things waiting for us in heaven.

Matt. 10:28 NIV - ²⁸ Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

Discouragement - We should have high expectations and strive for what is good and pleasing to God. However, Satan often tries to take something good and turn it into a source of discouragement.

Galatians 6:9 NIV - *⁹ Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.*

Strategies to Guard Against the Enemy

Be honest with yourself

Psalm 139:23 NIV - ²³ Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts.

Watch and Pray

Matthew 26:41 - ⁴¹ Keep watch and pray, so that you will not give in to temptation. For the spirit is willing, but the body is weak!

Know the enemy's strategy

*Study your life and ask, "Where does the enemy keep tripping me up?"
Recognizing these traps helps you avoid them in the future.*

Strengthen your weaknesses

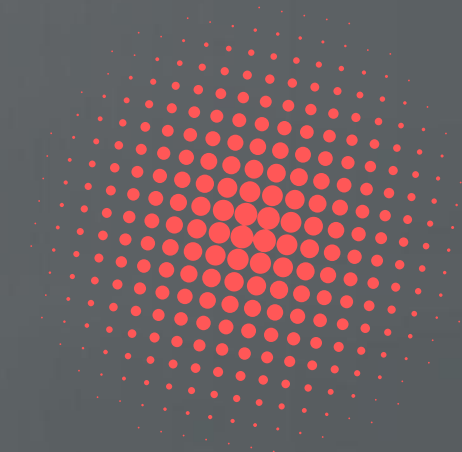
Ephesians 6:10NIV - ¹¹ Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil.

James 4:7 - ⁷ Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

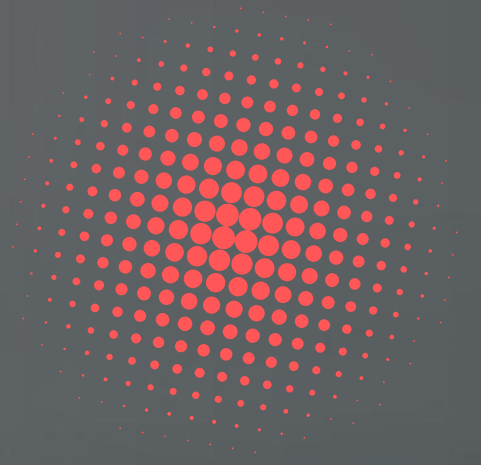
Conclusion
